Group 1: 1 additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or a Native language, or a classical or an international language, or social sciences and the humanities, or Canadian and world studies, or guidance and career education, or cooperative education;

Group 2: 1 additional credit in French as a second language, health and physical education, or the arts, or business studies, or cooperative education;

Group 3: 1 additional credit in French as a second language, science (Grade 11 or 12), or technological education, or computer studies, or cooperative education

Note: a maximum of 2 credits in French as a second language may count as additional compulsory credits, 1 credit from Group 1 and 1 credit from either Group 2 or Group 3.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Requirements

IB Diploma Subjects Available at Ashbury

Group 1: Studies in language and literature	English A, Literature; French A, Language and Literature, or a student's First Language A, Literature
Group 2: Language acquisition	Beginner, Core, Extended, Immersion French Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced Spanish
Group 3: Individuals and societies	History, Global Politics, Economics
Group 4: Sciences	Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Environmental Systems, Computer Science
Group 5: Mathematics	Mathematical Studies SL, Mathematics SL, Mathematics HL
Group 6: The Arts (or electives)	Visual Arts, Theatre; Music, or any other IB course

Diploma candidates must also fulfil all the requirements for:

- Theory of Knowledge
- Extended Essay
- Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS)

IB Bilingual Diploma

A Bilingual IB Diploma will be awarded to a successful candidate who fulfills one or both of the following criteria:

1. Completion of two languages selected from group 1 with the award of a grade 3 or higher in both
2. Completion of one of the subjects from group 3 or group 4 in a language that is not the same as the candidate's group 1 language. The candidate must attain a grade 3 or higher in both the group 1 language and the subject from group 3 or 4.

Ashbury Diploma Requirements

In addition to the OSSD requirements:

1. 1 credit in Physical Education
2. 1 credit with a global perspective at the grade 11 or 12 level
3. All English courses must be taken at Ashbury College
4. 9 terms of co-curricular involvement (at least one co-curricular activity is different from the others)
5. 20 additional hours of community service
6. No more than 3 senior credits from another institution.

Ashbury Bilingual Certificate

In addition to the OSSD requirements:

1. Completion of the Ashbury Diploma
2. 4 credits in Extended or Immersion French
3. 4 additional credits in courses where the language of instruction is French
